POLICY 422

SMOKE/TOBACCO-FREE ENVIRONMENT

The Board of Education recognizes the danger to health from smoking, the use of tobacco products and second-hand smoke. It believes that each student and employee should have the opportunity for full participation in instruction and employment in a smoke/tobacco-free environment.

All school district buildings, vehicles and properties will be smoke and tobacco free. Smoking and the use of other tobacco products is not permitted in private vehicles on school district property or at school/district sponsored events off school property. All district school property will have signage posted banning smoking.

Information regarding the hazards of smoking, the dangers of second-hand smoke and the use of tobacco products will be an integral part of district communication and education programs.
