## **POLICY 601**

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### **SELECTION OF LEARNING RESOURCES**

The primary objective of learning resources is to support, enrich and help to implement the educational program of the school. The Board will provide a wide range of resource materials to meet the diverse needs, interests and learning styles of students, that support a variety of teaching styles and provides a balance on differing points of view.

For the purposes of this statement of policy, the term "learning resources" will refer to information represented, accessible, or stored in a variety of media and formats, which assists student learning as defined by the learning outcomes of the provincial and local curriculum. Learning resources encompass a variety of media including video, software, print, and on-line information.

The Board delegates the responsibility for the selection of learning resources to the Superintendent and other professional staff employed by the school district.
