POLICY 608

ACCEPTABLE USE OF INTERNET ACCESS

The Board of School Trustees believes that electronic information research skills are necessary in preparing students for the future. The Board also believes that access to the Internet supports teaching and learning while promoting innovation and educational excellence through research, resource sharing and world wide communication.

The Board expects that Internet use will reflect academic honesty and high ethical and moral responsibility. Further, it is expected that users will restrain their consumption of shared resources, and also will respect intellectual property, ownership of data, system security, individual rights to privacy, and will ensure this use is free from intimidation, harassment and annoyance.
