POLICY 627

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The Board of School Trustees is aware of the value to all students of regular physical activity and the development of skills and attitudes that contribute to a healthful and enjoyable life. While the Board wishes to encourage gifted athletes, opportunity to develop skills and attitudes through extra-curricular activities should be available to all students. The Board, therefore, encourages teachers to provide leadership and supervision to students in a range of extra-curricular athletic activities stressing participation by many.

It is policy that school athletic activities be accorded the following order of priority:

1. The prescribed physical education programme.
2. Extra-curricular activities which encourage broad participation.
3. "Representative" teams which compete against other schools.
